JOB SUMMARY: Licensed Applied Behavior Analyst provides systematic behavioral assessments, functional analysis, and provides behavior analytic interpretations of the results, if severe behavior is present, functional analysis for safe testing in a controlled environment to services patient with Autism Spectrum Disorder (DSM 5) or an Autistic Disorder/Asperger's Disorder/PDD, NOS and provides adequate supervision to all paraprofessional staff and/or interns Behavior Technicians. This is performed in accordance with outpatient mental health clinic program ABA In Home and Center Based Program.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidate must have a Masters in Applied Behavioral Analysis, Counseling, Psychology, Social Work or Education with a concentration in Counseling or Doctorate degree in related field ; must have 2 years or more working with children and families or with mentally illness populations / individuals with disabilities and or Autistic Disorder/Asperger's, urban youth and crisis management. Licensed by the Mass Board of Registration of Allied Mental Health and Human Services Professions as an Applied Behavior Analyst and may be a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).

JOB SUMMARY: A Behavior Technician provides one- to- one strength based behavioral intervention services to patient with Autism Spectrum Disorder (DSM 5) or an Autistic Disorder/Asperger's Disorder/PDD, NOS in their homes and community. Behavior Technicians conduct home visit and are responsible for implementing Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) based programs as directed by Licensed Applied Behavior Analyst/ Board Certified Behavior Analyst Supervisor. Collect intervention data that targets specific behaviors (including frequency, rate, symptom intensity, and duration) incorporates objective baseline and quantifiable progress measures. Provides documentation on interventions and monitors care by completing progress notes based on each treatment plan daily and attending supervision weekly. This is performed in accordance with outpatient mental health clinic program ABA In Home and Center Based Program.

QUALIFICATIONS: Preferred candidate having a bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited institution and one (1) year of relevant experience working with families and youth. Candidates with no bachelor degree must have the following:

3. Two (2) years' experience preferred
