Therapeutic Mentoring & Therapeutic Training and Support

JOB SUMMARY: Provides direct one-to-one services with youth skill building using structured one-to-one strength based support interventions for the purpose of addressing daily living, social and communication needs and to learn new skills for improved functioning in the community. Provides documentation on interventions and monitors care by completing progress notes based on each treatment plan daily and attending supervision weekly. Interventions include teaching Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) skills, coaching, problem- solve and train guided by the goals that are established by master or doctor clinician level staff, youth's and their family on existing treatment plan. All work is conducted within community via home visits, school visits and work with other providers. Including direct time spent (attendance at IEP meetings, hospital discharge meetings, Care Planning Team (CPT) meetings, collateral contacts (phone and face-to-face), coordination, case management, skill building using Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) (parent, communication skills for both youth and their family) advocacy, navigating system and attending care plan meeting on youth and families behalf. Individual Community Support Habilitation Case Managers

JOB SUMMARY: The purpose of this position is to provide direct skill building using Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) and Substance Abuse interventions for individual, group and couples therapy. Utilize comprehensive, behavioral health assessment inclusive of the with fidelity in regards to process notes, treatment plans and assessments and discharge plan. Maintain records daily via input patient information in assessments, CANS, treatment plans, Risk management/safety planning, progress notes and billing. Identification of community resources and development of natural support options. As well as use DBT (Dialectical Behavior Therapy) and Substance Abuse treatment methods, coaching in support of decision-making in both crisis and non-crisis situations.

Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) Behavioral Technician

JOB SUMMARY: A Behavior Technician provides one- to- one strength based behavioral intervention services to patient with Autism Spectrum Disorder (DSM 5) or an Autistic Disorder/Asperger's Disorder/PDD, NOS in their homes and community. Behavior Technicians conduct home visit and are responsible for implementing Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) based programs as directed by Licensed Applied Behavior Analyst/ Board Certified Behavior Analyst Supervisor. Collect intervention data that targets specific behaviors (including frequency, rate, symptom intensity, and duration) incorporates objective baseline and quantifiable progress measures. Provides documentation on interventions and monitors care by completing progress notes based on each treatment plan daily and attending supervision weekly. This is performed in accordance with outpatient mental health clinic program.
