Our Day Services are structured, on site at our facility, group program for participants that need supervision that fosters community integration and offers assistance with a variety of healthcare needs acquisition, retention, improvement, communication of skills. We provide socialization, medication management, mental health services that takes place in at our program and at patient's private residence. Services often include assistance to learn activities of daily living and functional skills; language and communication training; compensatory, cognitive and other strategies; interpersonal skills; prevocational skills; and recreational and socialization skills. These services are provided by different therapist and other professionals on site at our facility.

Our Home and Community Based Services are for individuals who need support services in their own home, apartment and community needing supportive services. Services vary based on need and supports in a variety of activities such as instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs), support and companionship, emotional support and socialization, skill nursing, personal care and other health-related services. service enables the participant to retain independence or improve skills related to personal needs, health, use of community resources, community safety, physical assistance, supervision and other adaptive skills needed to live in the community. Positions under these services requires travel to work at patient homes and within the community.
